- Able to safely reside in the community, as determined by our interdisciplinary team

What does Summit ElderCare provide?

We provide geriatric case management, care coordination and additional services including but not limited to the following:

- 24/7 emergency access to a staff member
- Physical and occupational therapy
- Adult day services
- Medically necessary supplies and equipment

- Medically necessary transportation
- Nutritional counseling
- Caregiver education and support
