2021 Summary of Plan Benefits

This is a summary of drug and health services covered by Fallon Medicare Plus Super Saver HMO and Fallon Medicare Plus Saver No Rx HMO for January 1, 2021–December 31, 2021.

Fallon Health is an HMO plan with a Medicare contract. Enrollment in Fallon Health depends on contract renewal.

The benefit information provided is a summary of what we cover and what you pay. It does not list every service that we cover or list every limitation or exclusion. To get a complete list of services we cover, please see the *Evidence of Coverage* which is available online at fallonhealth.org/medicare, or by calling the phone number at the end of this book.

To join Fallon Medicare Plus (FMP), you must be entitled to Medicare Part A, be enrolled in Medicare Part B, and live in our service area. The service area for the plans listed in this Summary of Benefits includes all of the counties in Massachusetts except Dukes and Nantucket.

FMP Super Saver HMO and FMP Saver No Rx HMO have a network of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, and other providers throughout Massachusetts. If you use providers that are not in our network for these plans, the plan may not pay for these services.

Coverage Gap Stage

After your total yearly drug costs reach \$4,130 (includes the costs paid by both you and Fallon Health), you will pay 25% coinsurance for generic and/or brand-name drugs, and you will be in this stage until your total yearly drug costs reach \$6,550.

Catastrophic Coverage Stage

After your yearly out-of-pocket drug costs reach \$6,550, you pay the greater of: 5% coinsurance, or \$3.70 for generic or a preferred brand drug and \$9.20 for all other drugs.

Note: Fallon Medicare Plus Saver No Rx HMO **does not** include Medicare Part D prescription drug coverage.

Pre-Enrollment Checklist

Before making an enrollment decision, it is important that you fully understand our benefits and rules. If you have any questions, you can call and speak to a Fallon representative at 1-800-325-5669 (TRS 711), 8 a.m.–8 p.m., Monday–Friday (Oct. 1–March 31, seven days a week).

Understanding the Benefits

- Review the full list of benefits found in the *Evidence of Coverage (EOC)*, especially for those services for which you routinely see a doctor. Visit fallonhealth.org/medicare or call 1-800-325-5669 (TRS 711) to view a copy of the *EOC*.
- Review the provider directory (or ask your doctor) to make sure the doctors you see now are in the network. If they are not listed, it means you will likely have to select a new doctor.
- Review the pharmacy directory to make sure the pharmacy you use for any prescription medicines is in the network. If the pharmacy is not listed, you will likely have to select a new pharmacy for your prescriptions.

Understanding Important Rules

- In addition to your monthly plan premium, you must continue to pay your Medicare Part B premium. This premium is normally taken out of your Social Security check each month.
- Benefits, premiums and/or copayments/coinsurance may change on January 1, 2022.
- Except in emergency or urgent situations, we do not cover services by out-of-network providers (doctors who are not listed in the provider directory).
